

Manitoba Government Proposed Protocol for Greenhouses:

As permitted under the Public Health Act Order Regulations issued March 30, Agriculture and Food Production, Sections 20 and 22, greenhouse operations may remain open providing that:

- A sign is posted on the door with general cautions regarding Covid19
- Close onsite snack bars, coffee; close public washrooms
- Entry into business is regulated to prevent traffic congestion
- Use carts to ensure proper social distancing 2 meters apart
- External queue/ lines are managed in compliance with social distancing criteria
- Hand sanitizer, sanitizing wipes available on site so common areas can be wiped between customers, (carts, debit machines, door handles, counters)
- Flow control is implemented (one-way routes, marked out with social distancing in mind)
- Vehicle traffic flow is managed, which could include timed entry to regulate traffic congestion
- Employees are required to stay home if they are unwell or symptomatic
- Employees and customers have access to hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes
- May also operate with delivery or curbside pickup
