- Landscape Horticulture Certification Program: Participating in the creation of a strategic plan for future delivery of CNLA's landscape certification program.

These are some highlights of the current items being discussed at Manitoba PDC committee:

- Home + Garden Show: Members represented MBNLA at Ask A Landscaper booth. This
 brings attention to professionalism within the landscape industry. In 2024, MBNLA will
 not only offer this opportunities to members, we will also have a booth at the Winnipeg
 Renovation Show in January.
- **Career Fairs:** Put together information package for school boards introducing MBNLA to solicit invitations.

- Landscape Horticulture Certification Program: Promote awareness and support for Technician, Designer, Manager, Accredited Company designations.
- Micro-Courses: Identify industry training courses and organize events. First Aid, Chainsaw, Train the Trainer, HR competent on Hiring, Securing Load, Pre-trip, truck safety etc.
- Red Seal Horticulturist Reunion: Organize yearly networking event for apprentices and journey persons.
- Horticulture Club: Support this student lead club at Red College Polytechnic. This club connects students and faculty to our profession by offering events, workshops and fundraisers.
